Guidelines for Directed Study

One Credit Hour: Advanced submission and approval by the faculty sponsor of a substantive bibliography, independent reading on the part of the student, and two or more meetings with the faculty member over the course of the semester.

<u>Two Credit Hours</u>: Advanced submission and approval by the faculty sponsor of a substantive bibliography, independent reading on the part of the student, sustained writing of some kind, and frequent meetings (at least bi-monthly) with the faculty sponsor over the course of the semester.

<u>Three Credit Hours</u>: Normally three credit hours of independent study are reserved for course replacement (hence, full-syllabus, multiple writing assignments, and weekly meetings with the professor over the course of the semester) and independent research projects (including IRB work).
